

## **CPC Habitat Team 5 Report**

**Date: 04/09/09**

Our team of Debbie Koch, Tim Cassel, Dean Grothe and Dan McQueen arrived at 9:00. We found the fence posts we installed last week removed and replaced by a thick cement slab. We installed the basement steps railing and brackets for the upstairs railing. We installed the kitchen doorway casement and casement molding. We installed the entrance half wall and knee wall caps. We installed additional shelf brackets in the front bedroom closet and shelf supports in the basement stairs entrance. We installed linoleum in the front entrance and cut the linoleum for the bathroom floor. We cut out the wallboard from the bathroom ceiling and removed the vent fan and pipe where there was water damage from the roof leak. Dave Wunderink fixed the roof leak. We did some staining and filling of nail holes. We cleared more debris from the back created when whoever poured the cement slab. We cut kick boards for the kitchen base cabinets. The weather was mostly sunny and warm in the 60s. We quit at 4:35.

- Install bathroom flooring
- Install bathroom vanity, mirror and toilet
- Replace cut out wallboard in bathroom
- Install back fence
- Finish outside casements of front and back doors
- Polyurethane and install upstairs hand rail
- Install 2nd floor half wall cap
- Cut, paint and install closet shelving
- Install back bedroom closet door
- Stain half wall and knee wall underside of overhang
- Install quarter round molding in front entrance, kitchen and bathroom
- Install kick boards
- Install crown molding on kitchen wall cabinets
- Sand and paint new baseboard and casement
- Install one casement molding on kitchen entrance
- Install appliances and HVAC
- Install carpeting
- Install roof flashing on front
- Install fittings and kitchen sink faucet
- Install shower faucets
- Clean out basement

**Materials Needed for Next Time:**

- We used power and water from neighbor's house
- Fencing wire, gate, caps, etc.
- Bathroom vanity, mirror and toilet
- Hack saw to cut fence posts
- Quarter round molding
- Crown molding
- 1 Casement molding  $\geq 90''$
- 1x10s? for shelving
- Folding closet door
