Praise God for the two elder candidates who were examined on the 3rd. The session is enthusiastically recommending Pete Floyd and Jim Wilmot to the congregation for ratification as elders. Pray for these men as they prepare for approval by the congregation and ordination to the office of ruling elder.

Pray that we will be a church **where we are using our gifts in kingdom service**. Pray that we will know what gifts God has given us, and how He wants us to use them. In particular pray that God will provide the leaders we need for Home Fellowship Groups. Jesus told the disciples that the harvest is plentiful and that we are to pray for laborers to go out into the harvest. One key area of need at CPC is for more laborers to lead our Home Fellowship Groups and communities.

Pray for the Foltas as they are on Home Ministry Assignment from their work in Yanbian. Pray that God will open doors for P. University of Science and Technology so that these brothers and sisters can extend their outreach.

Tito Padilla, our church planting missionary in El Paso, Texas asks us to pray for their ministry to the growing number of youth in their church. Pray that the youth will love Jesus and grow as His disciples. Pray that God will use Tito to powerfully encourage us in kingdom ministry when he is at CPC during Missions Month.

Praise God for the progress being made on our third **Habitat** house in **Sandtown**, West Baltimore. Pray for a good relationship to develop between the homeowner, Andre Alston, and the CPC volunteers. Pray for safety, wisdom, patience, and servant hearts for all who work on the house. Ask God to raise the additional funds we need to fulfill our financial commitment to Sandtown Habitat.

This coming month we will focus on **missions**, and we will have speakers who are serving all over the world. Ask God to use this month to broaden our vision of what He is doing to build His kingdom around the world, and also to further equip us to participate in His global mission. This week **Richard Sharp**, who works with Operation Mobilization, will be preaching during worship and presenting his ministry in the Middle Hour. Pray that God will call folks from CPC to short or long term missions through our Missions Month.

We have just completed our sixth week of **Upward** games. Pray that the gospel will be clear to the teams, the parents, and the staff. Ask God to bring many to faith in Christ. Pray that those believers who are parents and/or staff will demonstrate Christ's work in our lives and that we will honor Him in how we represent Him this season.

Praise God that **Michael Belliveau** has returned from service in the Middle East and is back in Seattle with his bride Gina. Thank God for his clear calling for Michael and for the support he has felt from CPC.

Continue to pray for **CPC members and friends** who are recovering from illness or surgery or are grieving the loss of loved ones. Ask God to meet their needs and to teach us how to minister to each other.

- Pray for the **Sheldons** to have wisdom and comfort as they decide how to battle **Bob's** cancer.
- Pray for **George** and **Norma Walgrove**. Their daughter **Debbie** has been diagnosed with Spinocerebellar Ataxia, which is a degenerative neuro muscular disease.
- Pray for the **Propsts** as they care for **Colleen** who is having problems with spinal pressure and debilitating headaches. Ask God to give them wisdom as they interact with the doctors. Pray that God will relieve the spinal fluid pressure.
- Pray for **Abby Parke** as she heals from her broken arm, and from Pneumonia. Ask God to give her a quick and complete healing and that she will be home this weekend.
- Continue to pray for **Emily Lee**, who has Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) and is always at risk for respiratory illnesses. Pray that she will not have any new infections this winter. Pray for Nate and Diana as they care for Emily and Annabelle.
- Pray for the **Reichard** family. Gary's mom, Colleen Campbell, has been diagnosed with cancer in two sites.
- Continue to pray for **Kathryn Brod's** mom, **Anna Lasley** as she recovers from cancer surgery. Pray that the cancer will all be gone and that she will have a complete recovery.
- Pray for **Peter Johnson**, who has been diagnosed with a new blood clot in his leg. Ask God to remove the clot and to prevent any further clots from forming.

- **April Bly**, a former member of *CPC* and Linda Davidson's daughter, is having difficulty with her pregnancy. She is hospitalized at this point and we are asked to pray for a safe delivery and for comfort and care for the family.
