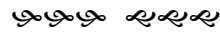

Jesus before three Jewish Judges in His trial:

**II. JESUS BEFORE CAIAPHAS  
Matt 26:57-68**

From Annas to Caiaphas. Further travesties of justice. Finally The Q: Are You the Messiah, the Son of God?! "You said it." (same words as v25) Then adds v64. They mock Him as prophet, and He states *most unlikely* prophecy He is most humiliated and powerless He speaks of coming in power and glory as Messiah in triumph The four reversals YOU WILL SEE:

- I. \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_  
You deny that I am Messiah.  
But **you will see** that I am the Son of Man, the glorious cosmic Ruler of Daniel 7:13-14!
- II. \_\_\_\_\_  
You think you are the judge judging Me. You sit; I stand.  
But **you will see** Me seated judging you. Cf. Matt 25:31-46  
Contrast this travesty of justice; then will be perfect justice.  
Even here, God's justice supersedes their injustice
- III. At the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Mighty One  
You say I am worthy of death as a blasphemer.  
But **you will see** Me exalted to the highest place where all will worship Me (Phil 2:6-11)!
- IV. Coming on the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_  
You think to kill Me and be rid of Me (John 11:49-50; 18:14 fulfilled!)  
But **you will see** Me again, not as a prisoner bound, but in glory, risen from the grave and ruling forevermore!  
These four things they denied. But **they will see**.  
And **so will you**.  
Right now you are in one of three positions:
  1. You \_\_\_\_\_ that these four things are true of Him, or you keep yourself from thinking about them.  
You do not worship Him or acknowledge your need of Him as your Savior and Lord. You live life on your own.  
Now as then He is silent before His accusers.  
But **you will see** that He is all He claimed to be.  
What if you see that too late??  
Come to Him now.
  2. You \_\_\_\_\_ He is all He says and you \_\_\_\_\_  
as if it is true.  
Not perfectly, but basically.
  3. You would \_\_\_\_\_ you believe v64. But you do not live as if it is true. Jesus is too much at the periphery of your life. Think of the implications of what you say you believe!  
Scorned and abused and tortured and forsaken. Crucified for you to take your punishment.  
Risen from the dead, Son of Man, Judge of the universe,  
Glorious in power and majesty. Sufficient for every need.
