- A look backward – *"in remembrance of Me..."*
- A look forward – *"you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes..."*

- With *thanksgiving* (*eucharisteo*) 1 Corinthians 11:23-24
- Cup of *blessing* 1 Corinthians. 10:16
- Communion with the Body of Christ (*koinonia*) 1 Corinthians 10:16-17
- The Table of the Lord 1 Corinthians 10:21
- The meal of the New Covenant 1 Corinthians 11:25-26
